THE PARTNERS SET UP AN EYE CHECK-UP CAMP AND PROVIDED FREE SPECTACLES AND HIGH-QUALITY DRY RATION

Vrindavan, Uttar Pradesh, May 20, 2023: Chetak Foundation, in association with Hiranmoyee India Foundation (HIF) and Visual Eyez, organised an eye check-up camp, provided free spectacles and distributed high-quality dry ration to the elderly women inhabitant of Radha Vinod Manipuri Aashram managed by HIF to improve their vision.

More than one hundred elderly women attended the camp. Free spectacles were provided to those who needed vision correction. The medical staff also identified women who were inflicted with cataract. An arrangement has been made with Visual Eyez and Bhakti Vedanta Hospital to carry out free cataract surgery for the identified women. Chetak Foundation also provided dry ration to the Aashram.

Speaking on the occasion, Pranab Saikia, Founder of HIF, said, "This initiative is a step towards helping elderly women to improve their vision. We are happy that Chetak Foundation has identified this critical area and organised an eye-check-up camp for Ashram inhabitants in partnership with Visual Eyez.
